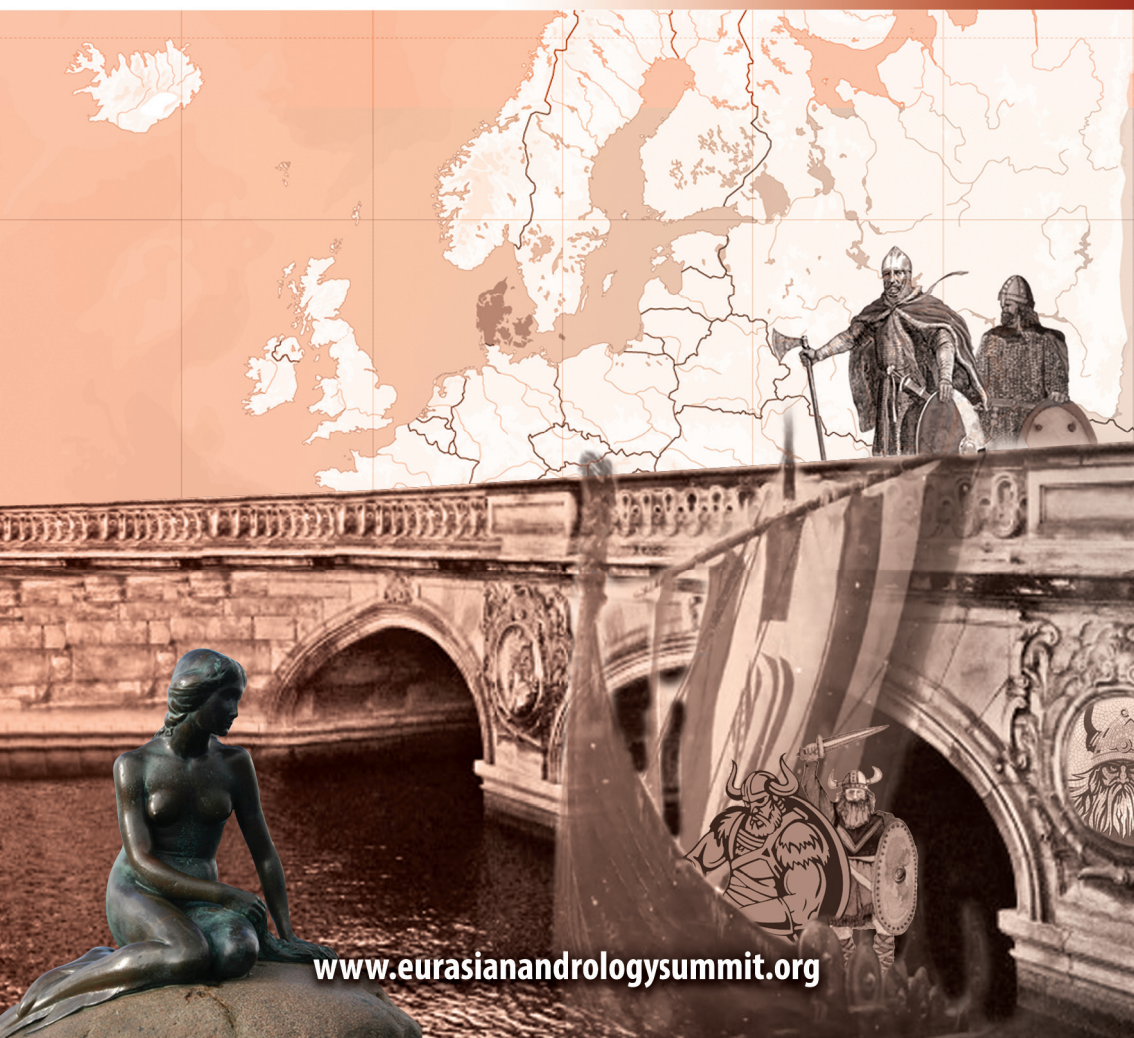




# 10<sup>th</sup> EURASIAN ANDROLOGY SUMMIT
